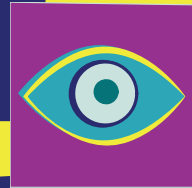
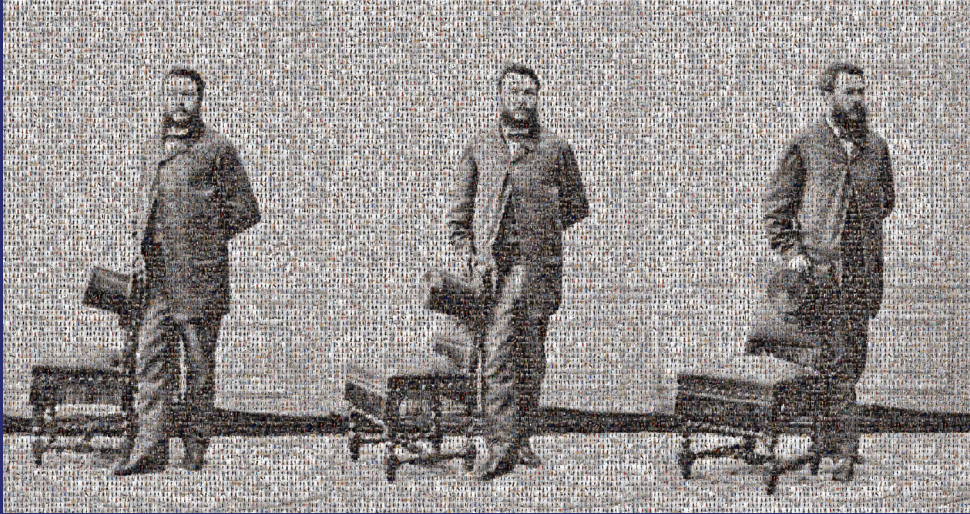

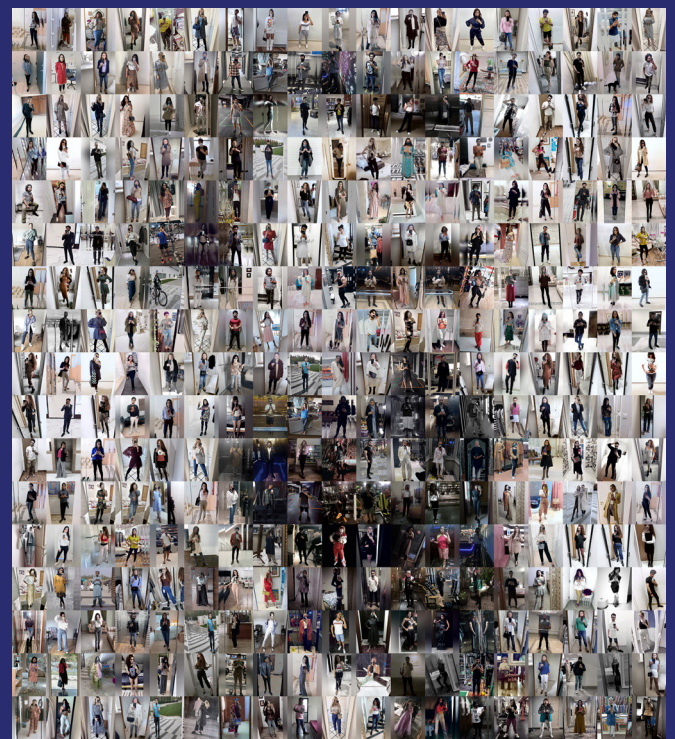
Look at this entire artwork.
